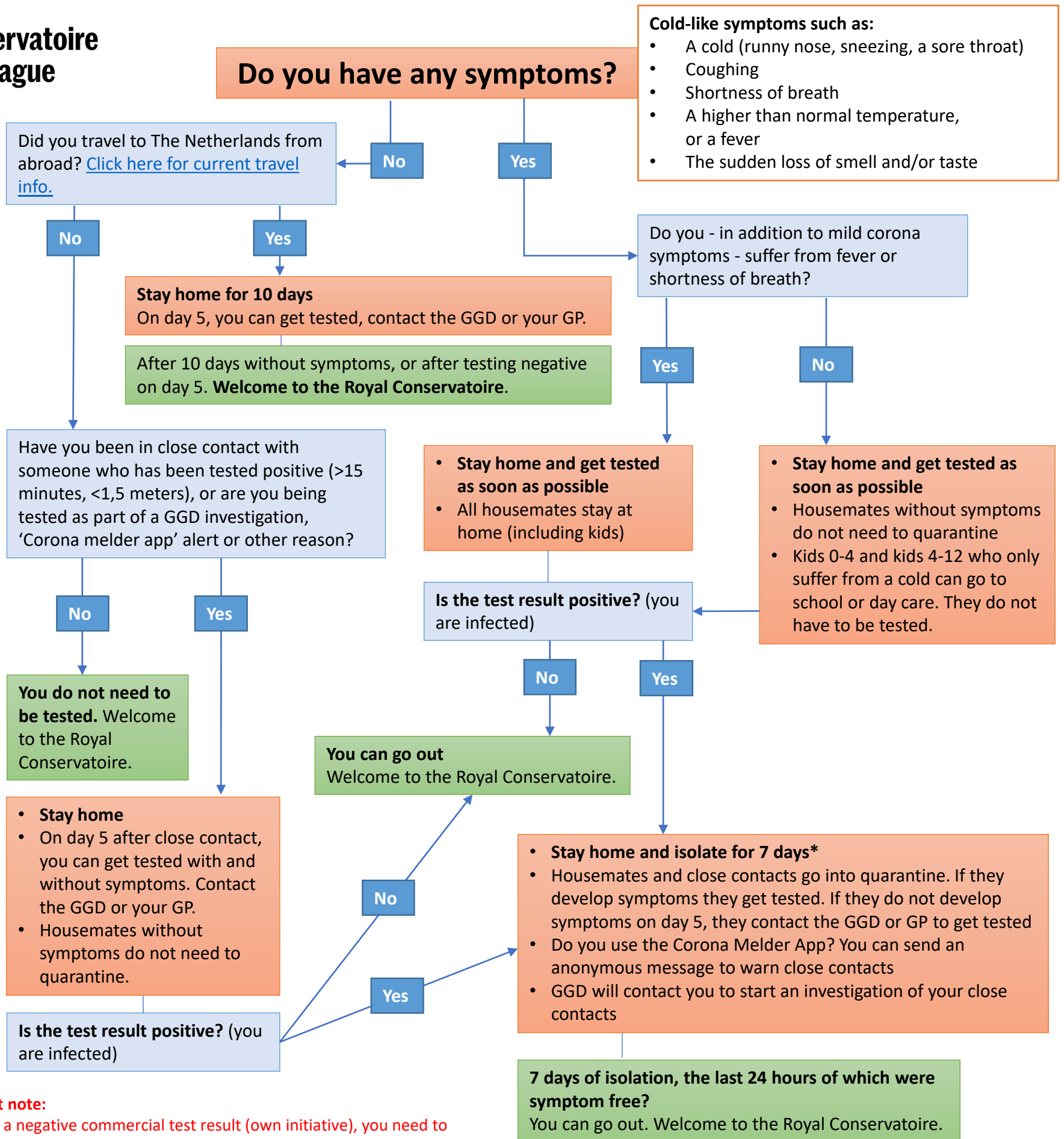


When to test and quarantine?

Important note:

Even with a negative commercial test result (own initiative), you need to uphold the above steps.

* Teachers and staff:

Follow sickness notification process and inform Head of Department

* Students:

Notify your Department Head or Coordinator.

You are not obliged to report a positive outcome of a Covid-19 test to the Royal Conservatoire. However, in the interest of ensuring a safe study and working environment for all, we strongly advise you to.

For all situations where you have to stay at home the following applies:

- Keep distance (>1.5 m) from your housemates (if possible)
- No visitors for neither you nor your housemates
- Don't leave the house except for GP/GGD appointment if you are Covid-19 positive

Quarantine is a precautionary measure. You are not sick but have been in contact with someone who is (possibly) infected.

If you have symptoms that match COVID-19, or you have been tested and the result is positive, you go into solitary **isolation**. You then stay at home, so that you do not spread the virus.
