

The following conditions apply for participation in the pedagogic lessons:

1. The student will give approximately 15 lessons between September 2020 and January 2021. If a student is unable to give this number of lessons due to a lengthy absence, an attempt will first be made to resolve the situation by finding a substitute.
2. In principle, a lesson lasts 45 minutes (depending on the instrument, it might be useful to shorten the lesson for beginners) and is given individually, unless the teacher decides otherwise. Another student may attend a lesson as an observer.
3. As a rule, lessons will be given in the Royal Conservatoire so that the student can be properly supervised by the teachers. The times of the lessons will be agreed between the student and the pupil.
4. Pupils must have their own instrument.
5. Pupils are expected to make time to practice every day. Attendance at the weekly lessons is compulsory. Pupils must display the right attitude to guarantee the continuity of the course for the student and the pupil.
6. The Royal Conservatoire reserves the right to terminate the collaboration if the pupil is found to display a lack of interest or is clearly unsuited for the instrument. Any such decision should preferably be made in the first months of lessons and may therefore entail discontinuation of the lessons. Any such decision will only be made after careful consultation with everyone concerned.
7. A pupil who is unable to attend a lesson should notify the student in good time.
8. Pupils should notify us if they intend to terminate the lessons prematurely.
9. Should problems arise in connection with the lessons, please notify the undersigned immediately so that a solution can be found.
10. If you wish to continue after completing the first 15 weeks of lessons, you will have to apply again for the next year.

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
