



Royal Conservatoire The Hague

The following conditions apply for participation in the pedagogic lessons 2026/2027

1. The student will give approximately 15 lessons between September 2026 and January 2027
2. Pupils must bring (buy or rent) their own instrument. **Please note that the Conservatoire does not rent instruments. Nor does the Conservatoire act as an intermediary.** It is recommended that you find out if you can arrange an instrument, before applying for the lessons. You cannot participate without your own (rented or bought) instrument.
3. Pupils are expected to attend all weekly lessons and to set aside time each day for study. Attendance at the lessons is mandatory and a prerequisite.
4. The pedagogical pupil must have own room to practice. The Royal Conservatoire does not have space available for this.
5. The lessons are free of charge. The costs for purchasing or hiring an instrument and for educational materials (reader, book e.g.) are at the expense of the pupil.
6. If a student is unable to give this number of lessons due to a lengthy absence, an attempt will first be made to resolve the situation by finding a substitute.
7. In principle, a lesson lasts 45 minutes (depending on the instrument, it might be useful to shorten the lesson for beginners) and is given individually, unless the teacher decides otherwise. The teacher and/or another student may attend a lesson as an observer.
8. As a rule, lessons will be given in the Royal Conservatoire so that the student can be properly supervised by the teachers. The times of the lessons will be agreed between the student and the pupil.
9. It is possible that the student makes video-recordings of the lessons for educational purposes. If this is the case we will ask your consent for making recordings.
10. The Royal Conservatoire reserves the right to terminate the collaboration if the pupil is found to display a lack of interest or is clearly unsuited for the instrument. Any such decision should be made in the first months of lessons and may therefore entail discontinuation of the lessons. Any such decision will only be made after careful consultation with everyone concerned.
11. A pupil who is unable to attend a lesson should notify the student in good time.
12. Pupils should notify us if they intend to terminate the lessons prematurely.
13. Should problems arise in connection with the lessons, please notify the undersigned immediately so that a solution can be found.
14. If you wish to continue after completing the first 15 lessons, you will have to apply again for the next year.
15. Your contact details will be shared with the student who teaches you, so that the student can contact you to plan the lessons.

16. If the pupil is a minor, parents/guardians must give written permission
